FOCUS applies a holistic approach to learning—emphasizing creativity, critical thinking and a shared film experience that impacts students from a variety of diverse backgrounds and subject areas.

FOCUS On Impact has explored topics such as homelessness, water pollution, refugees and the question – what does success look like? Students grapple with the most pressing issues of our day and interact with the filmmakers who are exploring these important topics. Film is a powerful medium of understanding. A film allows you to walk in another person’s shoes and understand an issue from a deeply connected point of view.
